



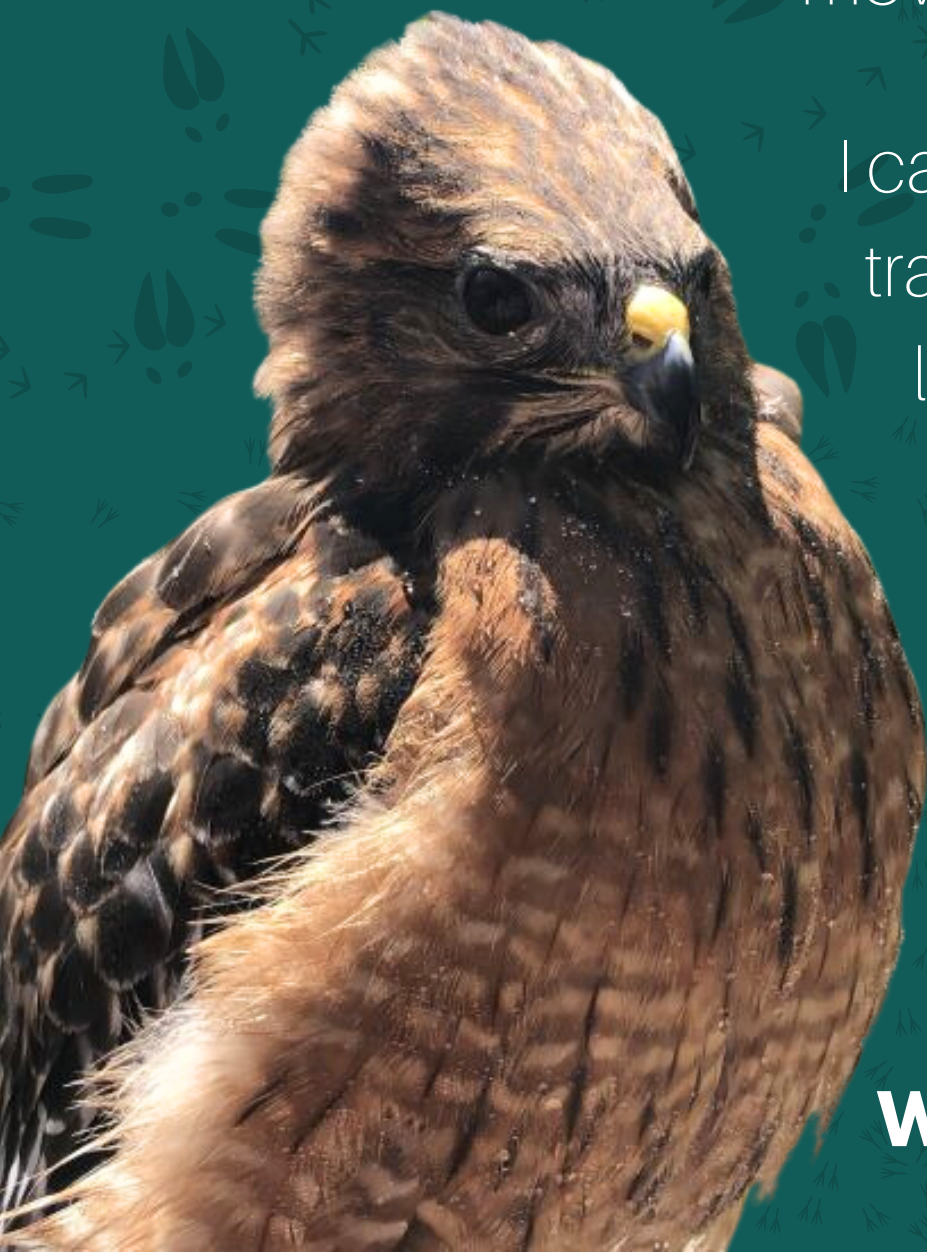
Red-Shouldered Hawk: 2 Truths, 1 Lie

largest birds in North
America

Great Horned Owl: 2 Truths, 1 Lie

I am one of the few
natural predators of
skunks

I can weigh up to
ten pounds

I can't digest bones,
skin, fur, or feathers

RED-SHOULDERED HAWK:

I sometimes hunt at night

EASTERN BOX TURTLE:

I don't like to share and can be very territorial

BARRED OWL:

EASTERN SCREECH OWL:

I am named after the sound I make (screech)

RAT SNAKE:

I don't actually eat rats

MOLE KINGSNAKE:

My pattern gets more distinct as I age

RED-TAILED HAWK:

I grow my red tail feathers within my first year of life

GREAT HORNED OWL:

I can weigh up to ten pounds
